ABOUT THE WASHINGTON YOUTH TOUR

ELIGIBILITY: Applicant must...

- be either a high school sophomore or junior;
- be at least 16 years old by June 13, 2019; and...
- have his/her parent's permission to enter and participate.

SYNOPSIS: Three teenagers from the Snapping Shoals EMC service area will be chosen to join dozens of other students, representing electric cooperatives across Georgia, on the Washington Youth Tour. It will begin with a banquet for participants and their parents. Then the Georgia students will enjoy a day of activities in their home state before flying to Washington, D.C., for an incredible week in

our nation's capital. Once they're in Washington, they will have the opportunity to meet Youth Tour students from all across the nation.

MORE ABOUT THE YOUTH TOUR

Snapping Shoals Electric Membership Corporation will be sending three high school students from our service area on an exciting, all-expenses-paid trip to Washington, D.C. These teenagers will join dozens of students from other electric cooperatives in Georgia to represent our state in the Washington Youth Tour, an annual event that brings around 1,400 young people from across the country to our nation's capital.

Youth Tour events for Georgia's participants will begin with a kick-off banquet for the students and their parents. The next day will be full of activities for the Georgia students before they fly to Washington. Youth Tour highlights typically include visiting the U.S. Capitol, U.S. Supreme Court, Holocaust Museum, MLK Jr. Memorial, Smithsonian Institution and, whenever possible, the White House. Other stops that are usually on the busy schedule are the National Cathedral and Arlington Cemetery as well as the World War II, Korean War and Vietnam War memorials and the Lincoln, Jefferson and FDR memorials.

In addition, students will have the opportunity to meet state and national leaders and gain a better understanding of how our government works. Participants will also be involved in leadership-building activities and will have the opportunity to interact with students from across Georgia and across the United States.

The Youth Tour is fun, fast-paced, well-organized and packed full of activities. Employees of Georgia EMC, the statewide EMC organization, organize the trip every year and are the tour directors. They do a terrific job of making sure that everything runs smoothly. Several EMC employees and their spouses serve as chaperones for the Georgia delegation, and teacher chaperones are chosen each year as well. *Details of departure and arrival times will be provided to participants and their parents before the trip.*

MORE ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The three winners of the Washington Youth Tour will also receive a \$500 scholarship from Snapping Shoals EMC. The scholarship will be made available for their use once they have completed high school and enrolled in an accredited two-year or four-year university, college or vocational-technical school. It is their responsibility to notify Snapping Shoals EMC when they prepare to begin college in order to receive their scholarship.

THE SELECTION OF PARTICIPANTS

Applications are scored by personnel from other EMCs. Scores are based on the information provided and the written essay. **Applicants will be required to come to Snapping Shoals EMC for a brief quiz.** Winners will be chosen based on their quiz score and their application score.
