Your cooperation helps ensure our crews can perform these duties safely and continue providing the dependable service you expect from your cooperative.

Members must provide employees and contractors of Snapping Shoals EMC access at any time to the member's premises for the purpose of:



Reading meters



Right-of-way maintenance, and repairing



Removing, inspecting or exchanging any equipment belonging to Snapping Shoals EMC.

Members must cooperate with employees and contractors of Snapping Shoals EMC in the performance of their duties and not interfere with or obstruct them in any way. A member shall not threaten or inflict (or attempt to inflict) injury to Cooperative employees, contractors, or property; any such action may result in disconnection without notice, expulsion of the member, or referral for criminal prosecution. 595272
