Home Weatherization

Help your wallet beat the heat

In addition to increased comfort, weatherizing your home is an excellent way to save energy and lower your cooling and heating costs. Here are three ways you can seal in comfort *and* savings.

1 Caulk

Apply caulk around cracks and openings between stationary components like door frames and window frames. 4613517



2 Weather Stripping

Install weatherstripping around components that move, like doors and operable windows.

3 Insulation

Adding insulation is an effective weatherization strategy, especially for older homes. Consider additional insulation in areas like an unfinished attic, exterior walls and floors above uninsulated spaces. 4555975
