LINEMAN SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP

DUE 02/20/2026

SSEMC offers two \$3,500 scholarships for those interested in attending lineman school. The funds may be used for any lineman school program in Georgia.

The winners must initiate their school registration within one year of award and must complete schooling within two years of award.



WASHINGTON YOUTH TOUR SCHOLARSHIP

DUE 01/16/2026

Snapping Shoals EMC awards an all-expenses-paid trip to Washington, D.C., plus a \$500 college scholarship, to four high school sophomores or juniors in our area each year.

Winners are chosen based on scholastic record, school activities, community service and other achievements.
